Travel summary

Arriving by Air:

Stansted Airport

Trains run direct from Stansted to Cambridge train station approximately once per hour. You can <u>check train</u> times here.

London Heathrow Airport

You should purchase a train ticket for your entire journey from London Heathrow to Cambridge. This is usually cheaper than buying separate tickets to London, then to Cambridge. Two options are available for the first part of the journey (Heathrow to London Paddington). You can enquire about these at the Heathrow ticket office, or follow the links below for more information.

1) Heathrow Connect (London Underground)

- Runs once every 30 minutes
- Takes 25 minutes (Terminals 1 & 2) OR 45-50 minutes (Terminals 3 & 4)
- Accepts railcards

2) **Heathrow Express**

- This is a premium service which is separate from normal rail services and costs extra. It is
 therefore necessary to buy two tickets, but you can buy both tickets at once at the normal ticket
 office.
- Runs once every 15 minutes
- Takes 15 minutes (Terminals 1 & 3)

OR 21 minutes (Term 5) OR around 25 minutes (Term 4)

Driving

We recommend you plan your journey using <u>Streetview on Google maps</u>, especially for the final part of your journey in Cambridge.

PLEASE INFORM THE SEMINARS ADMINISTRATOR THAT YOU WILL BE ARRIVING BY CAR, STATING YOUR LICENSE PLATE NUMBER, SO THAT THEY CAN ENSURE A PARKING PERMIT IS AVAILABLE TO YOU.

From the M11: Exit at junction 12 (to Cambridge, Sandy, and the A603) take signs to Cambridge on the A603. You will cross a large roundabout. At the second set of traffic lights, by the pub "The Hat & Feathers", turn left onto Grange Road. Take the second road on the right (Sidgwick Avenue). The Sidgwick site is on the left hand side of the road. Please park in the main car park. You can then pick up your parking permit from reception.

Arrival at the Faculty of Economics
